Anticimex will be coming to sanitize your home from bedbugs_____



Bedbugs are found all over the world and they have spread through the increase in travel. Bedbugs often arrive in your home via suitcases and hand baggage. We at AF Bostäder are doing everything we can to ensure that sanitization will be successful. As a tenant, you must also help by performing the following mandatory preparations before sanitization:

Wash all bedclothes, blankets/duvets¹⁾, cushions, curtains, clothes²⁾ and washable textiles in a washing machine at 60 degrees (at least).

- Put everything in sealed plastic bags and tie them up properly before taking them to the laundry.
- Do not open the plastic bags before you reach the laundry, and then only precisely before you put the washing in the washing machine.
- Dispose of the plastic bags at the area waste disposal station. Do not reuse them!
- Do not put the textiles back before Anticimex have sanitized the room.

1) If the blanket/duvet will not fit in the washing machine, you can tumble dry it instead at 60 degrees for at least 30 minutes, until it is hot all over.

2) If you have clothes or textiles that will not withstand washing at 60 degrees, you can put them in a drying cabinet or tumble drier at 60 degrees, until they are hot all over.




Move aside! In order for Anticimex to be able to apply pesticide to affected furniture and put silicon powder behind skirting boards, you must do the following:

- Push all the furniture together into the middle of the bedroom, so that it is at least **1 m** from the walls.
- Turn the bed and sofa on end, so that Anticimex can apply pesticide on the underside.
- NOTE! Do not move any furniture or suitcases outside the room that is affected! All of your things must be in the bedroom to avoid spreading bedbugs to other rooms or neighbours.
- If you live in an apartment, you should not move into another room or start sleeping on the sofa, since the bedbugs will move with you.

Clean up your entire home thoroughly before sanitization! It is important that you do the following:

- Clean the floor, skirting boards, cupboards/drawers and similar.
- If you vacuum clean or wash and dry, throw vacuum cleaner bags and cleaning cloths in the area waste disposal station for household waste immediately afterwards.

During their visit, Anticimex will apply pesticide to the floor, behind skirting boards, under beds and on other affected furniture. The pesticide is environmentally friendly and harmless to humans and pets. (Over-sensitive persons, i.e. those with asthma or allergies, children under 2 years of age, pregnant women and pets should not, however live in the home for 24 hours after treatment.)

What happens when Anticimex have finished sanitization?



In order for sanitization to be successful, the following advice should be followed:

- After sanitization, no one may be present in the house for 2 hours. Over-sensitive persons, i.e. those with asthma or allergies, children under 2 years of age, pregnant women and pets should not live in the house for the first 24 hours.
- If necessary, open windows and ventilate the room to quickly remove any smells when you return to your home. Ventilate in short intervals to avoid cooling down the house too much.
- It can take up to 24 hours for the pesticide to dry out completely. You should not replace textiles you have washed and tumble dried (at least 60°C) in wardrobes and drawers before this period is over.
- Anticimex use a long-life preparation that kills all bedbugs that come in contact with treated surfaces. NOTE! You may not wash & dry/vacuum clean closer than 20 cm to the skirting boards for 5 weeks after treatment, even if it seems that the problem is cured.
- Do not move beds, mattresses, duvets, blankets, pillows or other bedclothes during the sanitization period (approx 5 weeks) to any other room.
- Do not store things under beds or sofas during the sanitization period (approx 5 weeks).
